MAJOR REGULATION CHANGES FOR 2012

1.04E(1) Domicile and Residency Requirements.

Sections may create residency requirement rules to encourage and foster local league play.

2.01A Levels of Play.

Sections have the authority to choose straight or combined NTRP levels (3.0, 3.5, 4.0 or 4.5 or 6.0, 7.0, 8.0 9.0) for Super Seniors.

2.05E Players 70 and over promoted at year end. Change allows a player who is 70 years of age or older and promoted at year end, to appeal such rating based on his/her three most recent year-end ratings, rather than on the three prior consecutive years.

3.03A(6)

This change clarifies that an NTRP Grievance may not be filed at any time to prevent a conflict with Reg. 3.03E(3): NTRP Grievances may be filed at any time up to 48 hours after the conclusion of the Section Championship of the player against whom the NTRP Grievance was filed. NTRP Grievances will not be accepted at National Championships
